



Bonaire Extreme Duo Bonaire MTB Rules

Art. 1

Participation must be in teams consisting of two (2) persons, minimum age 15 years (born 1996 or earlier).

The finish time of the last team member is valid as the team time. It is not allowed to participate individually.

Art. 2

It is not allowed to exchange team members. You must race with the two (2) participants mentioned on the registration form.

Art. 3

A helmet must be worn at all times during the race.

Art. 4

The race number must be visibly attached to the front of the bicycle + at the back of the rider(s) at all times

Art. 5

It is not allowed to exchange (parts of) your bicycle during the race.

It is not allowed to accept outside help. Repairs such as changing of tires and tubes, cleaning of bicycles must be performed by the rider or his/her team member or from other participants. Participants can receive technical support from other participants.

Note: in the case of broken bicycles and participant(s) can't continue the race, volunteers at the water stations or check points can arrange for transportation assistance to Divi Flamingo or start-finish.

It is not allowed to discard bottles, tubes and/or gel packets on the route. **Please respect Bonaire's Nature** and only discard your waste visible for the volunteers at the checkpoints!

Art. 6

The race will start and finish at Divi Flamingo Resort. Deviating from the official race course is not allowed. The course will be marked with painted stone piles and signs indicating direction. Failure to follow the designated race course will result in disqualification. NOTE: Every participant is encouraged to finish the race at his/her own pace. However, official timing will close at 2 pm, after which the organization is not responsible anymore for providing water a/o checking the route. Race rankings and prizes will be announced at 1 pm at Divi Flamingo.

Art. 7

Failure to follow any of the rules can result in disqualification. In case the above rules are not clear, race management decides.

Art. 8

The following rules established by the Curacao Cycling Federation also apply to this race:

- Participants of the race should check-in AT LEAST 30 minutes before the race start (BEFORE 6:00 am).
- Race officials are authorized to inspect bikes, clothes and numbers and to provide advice. It is required to wear a helmet during the race and caps on handlebar ends. Failure to follow these instructions can result in disqualification.
- Participants are not allowed to be pushed or pulled by any vehicle, other participants or people. They will be disqualified. This does not include the provision of reserve materials such as food or drinks from other participants, or if other teams are used to shelter from the wind.
- Participants may finish the race by foot, as long as they bring their bike with them.
- Food and drinks can only be given from the right side of the road.
